The Technical Standards have been modified in the following areas:

Division 1 – General Requirements – Part 1.4 Submittals

Added content:

- Certificates of Inspection
 - ◇ 220500 for Plumbing Permits and Inspection
 - ◇ 223500 for Boiler Permits and Inspection

Division 22 – Common Work Results for Plumbing – Part 1.5 Quality Assurance

Added content:

- Permits and Inspections
 - ◇ The Plumbing Contractor shall obtain and pay for all permits required by the State of Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Plumbing Division.
 - ◇ The Plumbing Contractor shall submit, to precede request for final payment, a copy of the Certificate of Acceptance of the plumbing systems.

Division 22 – Domestic Water Heat Exchangers – Part 1.4 Quality Assurance

Added content:

- Permits and Inspections
 - ◇ The Plumbing or Mechanical Contractor shall obtain and pay for all permits required by the State of Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Boiler Division.
 - ◇ The boiler inspection certificate will be issued directly to the Owner by the Boiler Division, State of Michigan, after all required electrical, mechanical and plumbing permits have had a final inspection approval.
