Purpose:

The role of the Hidden Lake Gardens Garden Steward is designed to support a variety of tasks that enhance the beauty and functionality of Hidden Lake Gardens.

Responsibilities:

Plants, Trees, and Flowers:

- Potting, planting, and transplanting
- o Weeding, cultivating, pruning, and deadheading
- Propagating seeds, cutting, divisions
- Removing invasive and unwanted plants
- Watering

Custodial

- Sweep the lobby, walkways, and Greenhouse floors
- Placing and straightening plant labels, markers, and signs
- Setting up seasonal displays and special events
- Communication:
- Use a walkie-talkie radio to communicate with HLG staff.

Work Environment:

- This could be an outdoor environment and may be subject to changing weather conditions, as well as insects and wildlife.
- Volunteers should dress appropriately for the weather and take measures to protect themselves from these elements.
- All necessary tools to assist will be provided.

Dress Code:

 Volunteers must wear Hidden Lake Gardens apparel to ensure they are easily identified as authorized personnel when working within Hidden Lake Gardens.

Qualifications:

 Volunteers should have an interest in horticulture and plant care, the ability to perform physical tasks, attention to detail, and a willingness to learn.
